## Class Descriptions

---

### Being Catholic

What does it mean to be Catholic? Are there certain things you need to believe and follow? Does being Catholic affect what you do or what choices you will have in life? This class will provide an overview of some of the key teachings of the Roman Catholic Church such as the Eucharist, Mary, Vocations, the purpose of the Church, Heaven, Hell and Purgatory, Catholic symbols such as found in church architecture and how to live out the faith in your daily life.

### Eucharist

Ever wonder why Catholics think the Eucharist is so important? Have you ever questioned if the Eucharist really is Jesus' Body and Blood why does it still look like bread and wine? Want to hear about Miracles that have happened with the Eucharist? If you have said yes to any of these, or just want to know more about the Eucharist, this is the class for you!

### Marriage

Cinderella and Prince Charming, Shrek and Fiona, Bella and Edward- are any of these examples of true love or the makings of marriage? This class will talk about what God's plan is for marriage and how our society is living up to this plan. You will learn about what vows people make when they get married, what those vows mean and what good comes out of marriage.

### Prayer

We know we should be praying as Christians, but what is prayer? and is there more than one way to pray? In this class you will not only learn about prayer but have the chance to actually participate in different forms of prayer such as Adoration, Praise and Worship, *Lectio Divina*, and the Rosary.

### Sacraments (gathering to celebrate)

Most of us can agree that it is not easy to live out our faith in the world. The good news is Christ knew it would be hard, so he left His Church with some help: the 7 Sacraments. You might be able to name a few of the Sacraments, but do you know what they do or why we have them? This class will go through all 7 teaching you details that you probably have never heard about before.

### Spirit Sets Us Free

With only a few weeks left before you receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, we enter into an intense time of preparation, prayer and study on what the Sacrament is, how we can make final preparations and what God has in store for those Confirmed in His Church.

*\*Sponsors must attend this session (all 6 classes) with the candidate, unless they absolutely cannot, then a parent will take the place of the Sponsor\**

### Seeking Justice

When we think of social justice we normally assume that it is about helping people that are less fortunate than ourselves, but this class will show you how much more there is to social justice than just that one part. This class will answer questions like what power and role do political leaders have? Do we have to care about politics as Catholics? Why do we have to work, and what rights should workers have? Are families important for society? What rights do humans have when they are in the womb or dying or anywhere in between?
